PADI IDC Staff Instructors are PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainers who have successfully completed an IDC Staff Instructor course. During their training, IDC Staff Instructors overview the entire PADI instructor Development program and learn to act as assistants during instructor-level training courses. IDC Staff Instructors work with PADI Course Directors to develop instructor candidates' teaching abilities as well as shape their attitudes as dive professionals.

In addition to all the courses you can teach as a PADI Instructor, you can also:

- Teach PADI Assistant Instructor courses.
- Assist PADI Course Directors in conducting the PADI Instructor Development Course.
- Assist PADI Course Directors in conducting instructor-level continuing education.

PADI IDC Staff Instructor Prerequisites:

To enroll in a PADI IDC Staff Instructor Course the candidate must:

- Be a renewed and in teaching status as a PADI Instructor for the current year.
- Hold a PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer rating.
- Agree to conduct all levels of diver training consistent with the standards and philosophy outlined in the PADI Instructor Manual.
- Agree to use the PADI System and components in its entirety.
